What you need to know before you arrive

the 2026 24 Hours of Trucks — BTRC.

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ARRIVAL & CIRCUIT ACCESS

Arrival times

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24

9:00am → 9:00pm

Truck arrivals in the paddock — no entry after 9:00pm.

- You must pass through the Accreditation Center (Stade Marie-Marvingt) before accessing the circuit.
- Arriving in several groups: prepare additional envelopes directly at the Accreditation Center.
- Accreditation is required to enter the circuit — including via the South Gate, open continuously until Sunday evening.

DON'T FORGET

No cars in the paddock

Parking required in P2B or the free outside parking area — vehicles in breach may be towed.

Fuel limit

Maximum 200 litres remaining in your trucks' tanks.

Animals not allowed

No animals are permitted inside the circuit grounds.

LIFE ON SITE

MOTORHOMES

Must be declared before the event (4 so far). Parked strictly at the rear of your structure — no motorhome visible at the front.

WIFI

An individual Wi-Fi code will be provided to each team.

MOVEMENT ON SITE

Speed limited to 30 km/h for electric scooters and mopeds. Wearing a helmet is MANDATORY.

Paddock DEPARTURE

Teams may vacate the paddock from the end of the last race on Sunday until Monday, September 28, 12:00pm.

Each parking sticker must be affixed to the vehicle's windshield. Once affixed, it cannot be removed or replaced.

RULES TO FOLLOW & EXTRA TICKETS

Rules to follow

- Your accreditation is a working tool: it is your passport to the event.
- It gives access to secure areas corresponding to each person's mission.
- Must be worn at all times on site, starting on Thursday.
- The issuance of accreditation implies acceptance of the accreditation charter and the rules in force.
- Strictly personal and non-transferable: it must not be lent or given to a third party.
- Anyone found in possession of an accreditation that does not belong to them will face penalties.

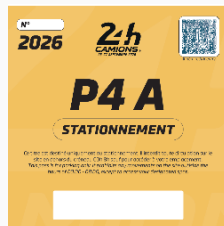

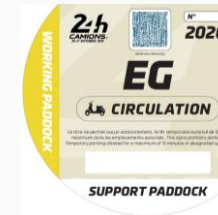

PARKING RULES

- Sticker affixed to the windshield, before arriving at the circuit entrance.
- Parking permitted ONLY in the area indicated on the sticker.
- No movement on site outside the 12am–8am window, except to reach your parking space.
- A pass without a barcode does not grant access to the Circuit.

EXCEPTION ON THURSDAY & FRIDAY

Any vehicle with a parking sticker is allowed access to Paddock P4AB.

Bicycles: no vehicle pass required, but access is limited to that of the accreditation — reserved for accredited persons.

Installation: bottom-left corner of the windshield. An unaffixed sticker is invalid. In case of fraud: pass blacklisted and/or vehicle impounded.

Access reserved for holders of a track accreditation (zone 6 — driver / team manager). Bring your driver's license for the administrative check.

- 11:05am** Drivers' meeting — at the foot of the Welcome Centre (P5C)
- 11:15am** Picture

This photo is mandatory for all French, European, and British drivers.

RACE TRUCKS PHOTO

- After Private Practice 2 (4:30pm), complete a deceleration lap and come to a stop at the final corner, following the marshals' instructions.
- Once in position for the photo, move forwards to clear the way.
- After the photo, the track is cleared via the P5C.

Photographers: access via the P5C once all Race Trucks have been positioned.

DRIVERS' BRIEFING & TRACK WALK



4:45pm

Drivers' briefing

Briefing room No. 305, 3rd floor of the Paddock Building. Attended by the drivers and the team manager.



7:00pm – 8:00pm

Drivers' track walk

On foot or by bicycle.



The drivers' briefing must be attended by both the driver AND the team manager of each team.

OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY

On-track ceremony bringing together all race trucks (CDF, ETRC, BTRC) and their teams.

12:15pm	Trucks (drivers wearing the green CEREMONY wristband) gather at the pre-grid
12:15–12:40pm	Trucks positioned on the track, in pairs, following the marshals' instructions
12:40–1:25pm	Grid walk — access restricted to GRIDWALK (orange) or CEREMONY (green) wristbands
1:10–1:25pm	Grid walk cleared — only CEREMONY (green) wristbands remain on the track
1:20pm	Each team lines up next to its truck (driver on the truck side, facing the track)
1:30pm	Official presentation
1:40pm	Trucks cleared via the P5C

WRISTBANDS & OUTFIT

5 wristbands per entered truck: 1 driver + 4 mechanics in team uniform.

Outfit: racesuit for drivers, team kit for team members.

Only accredited media photographers wearing an ACO bib are allowed on track.

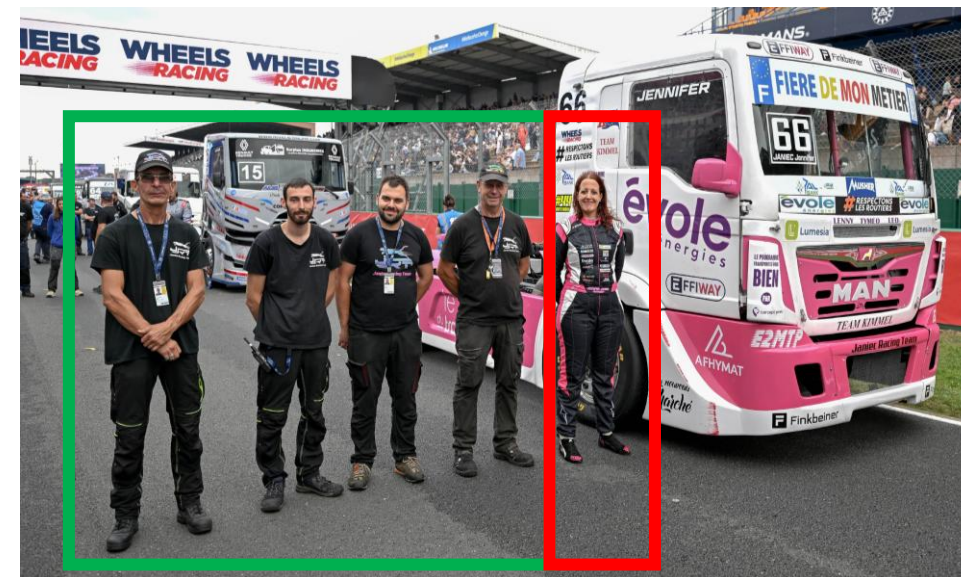
