Track Parade - due to the limited number of vehicles we can accommodate within each time session it may not be possible for all entrants to take part in the parades. However, we are happy to reserve a number of spaces for each club stand and confirm the actual number taking part nearer to the event.

A vehicle pass and two wristbands will be handed out to each exhibitor at the "Check point" within the circuit.

Terms and conditions – these need to be relayed to those displaying a vehicle.

By entering the event the participant is agreeing to the terms.

Due to the nature of this event, only the vehicles entered for the display are allowed to park on the stand

Any vehicle trailered to the event will need to be unloaded in a designated location and then driven to the appropriate display area.

Due to restrictions on vehicle movement within the circuit please be aware that all vehicles need to be in the designated

display area by 10.00am on Saturday morning and 9.00am on Sunday morning. We cannot guarantee the entry of any vehicle arriving after these times.

For the safety of the public on site, vehicles must not leave before 4.00pm unless permission has been given by the Manager.

Strictly - ANIMALS are NOT allowed on the site.

Each participant confirms they have a minimum of third party insurance (in accordance with the Road Traffic Act) in respect of thevehicle entered in the event.
