ROADSPORT RACERS REVVED UP FOR ISLAND ADVENTURE

The Bilstein Caterham Roadsport Championship continues at apace this Saturday as the popular single-make series descends on Oulton Park to write the latest chapter of what has already been an action-packed campaign.

Effectively year two of the Caterham Academy Championship, the Roadsport category is the second step on the Caterham Motorsport and as such, much of this year's grid know each other well having competed against each other last year.

Simple developments to the car - including track-focused Nova ZZS tyres and a rear anti-roll bar - offers driver progression in what is relatively similar machinery to that of last year; all while now in a double-header race format.

Oliver Smith arrives at the Cheshire venue as the driver to beat, with his front-running form of late having enabled him to build up an impressive 17-point advantage over his nearest challenger, Kyle Townend.

Smith was one of the stars of the show when the series raced at Spa-

Francorchamps and after claiming two wins in Belgium, he added to his silverware collection back on British soils as he turned heads at Donington Park.

He'll undoubtedly be one to watch, but so too will be Townend, who has been a regular fixture on the podium this year. Richard Davies meanwhile is not to be overlooked as he bids to regain control after leading the championship just a few rounds ago.

Mitchell Fasanya sits fourth and has been a consistent presence towards the front of the field. So too has Matthew Fox, John Bond, Ben Oliver, Richard Northridge, Steven Vischer and Georgie Tuffin.

Other notable names that could play their part in who walks away with a trophy or two is Sam Emission, Richard Watson, James French, Rob Hicks, Heinrich Watson-Mill, Luke Wilson, Archie Kennedy-Dyson and Mark Hensler.



CATERHAM SEVEN 270R CHAMPIONSHIP

OGGELSBY OUT FRONT AS 270R CONTENDERS DESCEND ON OULTON

Paul Oggelsby has been the benchmark driver in the FanDrive Caterham Seven 270R Championship for much of 2026 and as the series now enters the business end of the season, he's looking to kick on and extend his advantage at the top of the standings.

Marking the third rung on the Caterham Motorsport ladder, the series features drivers that have competed in both the Academy and Roadsport, while the addition of a third race and support from professional teams ups the ante further.

The Seven 270R car progresses the Roadsport race car too by switching from road to track suspension, plus the removal of the windscreen and lights to make it look and feel like the racing machine that it is.

Oggelsby - who is a former Academy champion - has been nothing short of sublime this term with his eye-catching

speed and consistency ensuring that he has tallied multiple race wins and podium finishes.

Arriving at Oulton Park with a 15-point lead, Oggelsby will by no means be taking his foot off the gas. If anything, he'll have it pressed to the floor as he bids to extend his advantage over the chasing pack.

Leading that is Luciano Caruso while Sebastian Tholet is a further two points in arrears of him. Throw into the mix Aaron Oliver and Henry Speeks, and it's clear to see that anybody could stake their claim in the race for the overall title.

Both Brian Thornton and Scott Helme are next up in the standings and neither of them can ever be discounted from inserting themselves into the championship conversation. They'll each need good fortune to fall their way however.

A watchful eye should also be cast over the likes of Jasmine Shaw, Craig Evans, Alastair Morton, Christian Bond, Oliver White, Jimmy Was, Steve Lorrman, Andrew Bailey, Gary Cross, Ryan Tholet and Charles Chapman.

CATERHAM SEVEN 310R CHAMPIONSHIP

CATERHAM SEVEN 310R RACERS PRIMED FOR ACTION IN CHESHIRE

It's been another vintage season for the Vertex Caterham Seven 310R Championship and with a number of drivers still firmly in contention for the overall title, all bets are off going into the home stretch - starting here at Oulton Park.

Providing the penultimate step on the ladder for the proficient race driver in a car that started life in the Academy Championship the Seven 310R category is the ultimate evolution of the Academy car, the machines that compete in the 310R ranks produce in excess of 152bhp.

Having already make a popular guest appearance on the British Touring Car Championship support bill at Brands Hatch, the Seven 310R category has delivered plenty of blockbuster moments - and more are expected this Saturday in Cheshire.

With experienced racers going wheel-to-wheel with fledgling talents, this year's entry list has arguably been the most competitive in recent memory. And sitting atop the pile as it stands is William Harris.

Having clinched 270R title glory last year,

Harris is looking to make it back-to-back triumphs this year; and he's shown he has all the tools necessary to do achieve the feat as well.

Another former champion, Paul Goldstein, understands what it takes to win and he will be hoping to turn the wide around Oulton Park's challenging Island layout this weekend.

William isn't the only Harris to look out for either as his brother Charles is very much within striking distance in third place. And along with William Chadwick and Ben Lopez Appleton, a captivating prospect lies in wait.

Of course its not just the top five that is worth looking out for as drivers such as Alex Vincent, Ryan Wilby, Sam Parker, Steven Lancaster and Chris Buck could impact proceedings at the front of the field.

O'FLANAGAN IN CONTROL IN SEVEN CHAMPIONSHIP UK

Taylor O'Flanagan will continue his pursuit of history in the Motul Caterham Seven Championship UK at Oulton Park this weekend, as he looks to clinch what would be his fifth and final title on the Caterham Motorsport pyramid.

As the only nationally recognised top-tier Caterham racing series in Britain, the Seven Championship UK holds immense prestige and as it stands, it is the only crown that O'Flanagan has yet to get his hands on.

Rising through the ranks and winning in the Academy, Roadsport, 270R and 310R categories in recent years, the rapid racer has taken no time at all to settle into life in Caterham's premier class - which is as competitive as it gets.

Tallying multiple wins and podiums this year, O'Flanagan will be hoping to stretch his 11-point advantage in Cheshire because snipping at his heels is last year's vice-champion, Harry Senior.

After coming oh-so close to the coveted crown, Senior has returned and is driving arguably better than ever. He's very much within striking distance of O'Flanagan too, which means fans can expect a ding-dong battle around the Island layout of Oulton Park.

Charlie Lower has been another to impress and like Senior, he'll be looking to make inroads towards the top of the standings, while also bidding to stay ahead of Steve Nuttall and reigning champion Matt Armstrong.

Henry Heaton has demonstrated on countless occasions that he can challenge for outright honours while Justin Armstrong, Craig Storey, Nick Highton and Chris Fraser are among the long line of other drivers that will be worth looking out for across Saturday's two races.

BLUE

(Double Waved) Great danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.



WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.



GREEN

Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.



RED

Stop Racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by a marshal (at startline and individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.



BLACK/ORANGE DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver; call into pits immediately.



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to drivers that his/her behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he/she may be black flagged.
