CAMPSITE DOS & DON'TS

Out of courtesy to your fellow campers, please keep within your allocated pitch. Please park your caravan/tent/motorhome in a neat fashion and ensure that fire lanes are not blocked or obstructed. Overnight camping in any of the Car Parks is strictly prohibited

There are numerous fire extinguishers situated around the campsite, please familiarise yourself with the location of these at the start of your stay

Please dispose of all rubbish in the bins provided

Ensure all valuables are securely locked away and kept out of sight. Please be aware that despite the organisers taking every possible precaution, there may be uneven ground and the possibility of rabbit holes

Please take care when walking around the campsite, it's highly recommended that you carry a torch with you at night to avoid any potential trip hazards/rabbit holes

We're very happy for spectators to walk around the circuit from 19:30hrs, after racing has finished for the day. Please ensure that you remain on the circuit itself and under no circumstances venture onto the Airfield. Thruxton is an active Airport and remains open to aircraft/helicopters 24hrs a day including Hampshire & Isle of Wight Air Ambulance, trespassing onto the Airfield carries a fine imposed by the Civil Aviation Authority of up to £5,000

All water outlets around the circuit are potable. Please ensure taps are turned completely off when not in use

All music and generators must be turned off by 11pm. Unruly/abusive behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances and Security are instructed to remove from site any person(s) in breach of this

Temporary toilets and showers are located towards the middle of the campsite and are serviced regularly. There are also permanent toilets at both Allard and Campbell corners. Should there be an issue with any of these facilities, please let a member of our Security team know and they'll inform the appropriate people

STRICTLY NO FIRE PITS OR OPEN FIRES

Please raise BBQ's off the ground. No disposable BBQ's to be put into waste bins under any circumstances as this causes a major fire risk
