



Ground Floor Layout

A grand atrium entrance lobby greets guests when they walk in to the Thruxton Centre. Located on the ground floor is the main restaurant and bar which turns in to 330 m2 of exhibition space. Access to bring in vehicles/large items to this space is also available. Also located on the ground floor are two classrooms, which can be joined to form a single larger space. Lift access to the first floor, male and female toilets, including disabled facilities. Plus, kitchen and service areas.



The first floor of the Thruxton Centre offers stunning views of the race circuit (the fastest in the UK) and the rest of the venue. Located on the first floor is a 135 m2 hospitality space, which can also be divided in to three separate hospitality suites, each with 45 m2 of floor space. Step outside on to the viewing terrace and balcony with unrivalled views of Thruxton. Also located on the first floor are male and female toilets, including a disabled toilet. Plus, a meeting
