CAMPSITE DOS & DON'TS

Your Camping Pitch

- Please stay within your allocated pitch and position tents, caravans and motorhomes neatly. Keep fire lanes clear at all times.
- Overnight camping in any car park is strictly prohibited. Please dispose of all rubbish in the bins provided.

Staying Safe

- Max 5mph in campsites and car parks.
- Use the perimeter road to access campsites B and C – do not drive through campsite A
- Keep valuables locked away and out of sight.
- The campsite has areas of uneven ground and rabbit holes, so please take care when walking around.
- We strongly recommend carrying a torch at night to help avoid potential trip hazards.

Evening Circuit Access

- Spectators are welcome to walk around the circuit from 7.30pm, once racing has finished for the day.
- Please remain on the circuit at all times and do not enter the airfield.
- Thruxton is an active airport operating 24 hours a day, including use by the Hampshire & Isle of Wight Air Ambulance.
- Unauthorised access to the airfield can result in a Civil Aviation Authority fine of up to £5,000.

Water & Facilities

- All water outlets around the circuit provide potable drinking water.
- Don't rinse out foul waste containers.
- Please ensure taps are fully turned off after use.
- If you see a water leak, please report it.
- Temporary toilets and showers are located towards the middle of the campsite and serviced regularly.
- Permanent toilets are also available at Allard and Campbell corners.
- Permanent showers are also located in the paddock.
- If you find a problem with any facilities, please report it to the Security Team - 01264 882212.

Noise & Behaviour

- All music and generators must be switched off by 11pm.
- Please be considerate of fellow campers throughout your stay.
- Unruly or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated. Security may remove anyone who breaches these rules from the site.

Fire Safety

- Fire extinguishers are located throughout the campsite. Please familiarise yourself with your nearest fire point when you arrive.
- Never block or obstruct designated fire lanes.

STRICTLY NO CHARCOAL BBQ'S, FIRE PITS OR OPEN FIRES

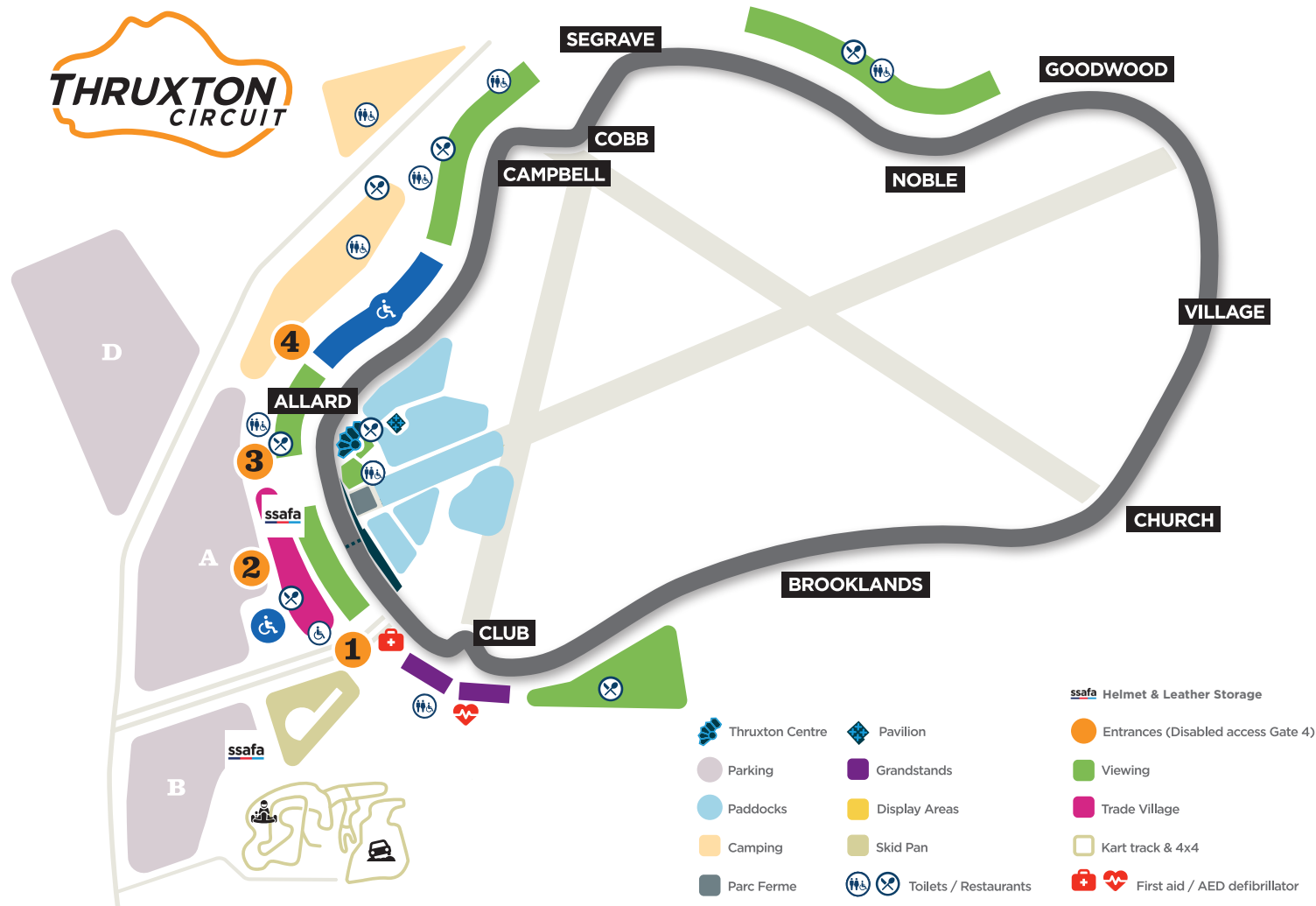
Due to the hot, dry conditions and increased fire risk, charcoal and disposable barbecues and open fires are not permitted anywhere on site.

Gas barbecues are permitted but must be positioned at least 60cm above the ground on a suitable stand.

Fire points are located throughout the campsite, and we encourage campers to bring a fire extinguisher and/or fire blanket where possible.

Food and drink will also be available from campsite concessions and the Thruxton Centre throughout the weekend.
